To this end, one would use any number of postcards with scenes from British colonies, Italian destinations and Greek (there being a hefty Maltese contingent in Corfu, for example, as well as in Alexandria, Algeria and Tunisia). Therefore most of the postcards sent from Malta pre-1910 would include scenes from Gibraltar, Mallorca, Corfu and Greece, Port Said and Alexandria, Naples, Rome, Catania etc. Two Embroidered postcards (popular at the time), celebrating the Onomastico -\*515 €75 the feast day of a Saint that carried one's name. A single postcard which was sent by owner's grandfather (in Malta) to his \*516 €75 fiancee, his grandmother, living in the French colony of Bone/Bona in Algeria... the place where the surname Ta' Bona / Tabone comes from, having had a large Maltese population for some 200 years. What makes it more interesting is that is it one of the first postcards with MALTA being promoted on the facade -Greetings from Malta. Du Royaume de Naples, Voyage a L'Isle de Malte, complete. \*517 €700 A handwritten letter, with red wax seal, dated 1787, sent by a certain French \*518 €1,200 knight [?] with the surname Freixenet, to the Commander Prevost of the Auberge of the Noble Langue of Provence, La Vallette, Malte... Via Marseilles. The name of the ship that carried the letter is (item/s 35. continued) also stamped on the cover sheet - the CORDE. Such letters are almost impossible to come by and very very few, if any, still exist. An assortment of books including Rajt Malta Tinbidel Vol.I.II.III.IV by Herbert \*519 €335 Ganado, Requiem for a Malta Fascist, by Francis Ebejer, Hitan by Francis Ebejer, Ir Ragel li Hadha mal Mewt by Erin Serracino Inglott, Come Again in Spring by Francis Ebejer, Leap of Malta Dolphins A Novel by Francis Ebejer, A City by an Order by Roger de Giorgio, The Siege of Malta 1565, The Maltese a Collection of Portraits and Biographies by Tony S Mangion. Album (mustard) with 128 COUSIS cigarette cards, late 19th, early 20th century. \*520 €1.000 Cousis was a successful Maltese cigarette manufacturer based in Alexandria Egypt, where there was a sizeable Maltese expatriate community, and was a main sponsor for various musical events throughout the year in Malta (ads in

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programmes, theatres etc.). The company ceased manufacturing cigarettes before

WWII since British imported cigarettes took over the Maltese market.
